Dear Ms. Dortch:

The purpose of this letter is to amend the above-referenced application (the "Application") pursuant to Section 1.65 of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.65, by which Spirit Television LLC ("Spirit") seeks Commission consent to assign the license for earth station E910146 (the "Earth Station") to Parker Broadcasting, Inc. ("Parker"). Specifically, Spirit hereby amends the Application by supplementing the existing response to Question 43 of the Application. In addition, although Parker is not controlled by another entity, in response to an informal request by the Commission's staff, Spirit is submitting an Exhibit E in response to Question A20 of the FCC's Form 312 application form.

The Application was filed concurrently with a second assignment application which also seeks Commission consent to assign the license for the Earth Station. The other assignment application seeks to assign the Earth Station license from Catamount Broadcasting of Fargo LLC ("Catamount") to Spirit (File No. SES-ASG-20060727-01276). The Application is contingent upon the FCC granting the assignment of the Earth Station license from Catamount to Spirit.

The Earth Station which is the subject of the above assignment applications is used in connection with full-power television station KXJB-TV, Valley City, North Dakota, which is currently licensed to Catamount. Separate assignment applications have been filed with the FCC's Media Bureau to assign the license for KXJB-TV from Catamount to Spirit, and, in turn, from Spirit to Parker.

Upon FCC approval of all four assignment applications, the parties anticipate holding a simultaneous closing in which the licenses for KXJB-TV and the Earth Station are assigned from Catamount to Spirit, and then immediately from Spirit to Parker. Therefore, Spirit respectfully requests that the Catamount/Spirit assignment application (File No. SES-ASG-20060727-01276) and the Application be expeditiously processed and granted simultaneously.
