The beneficiary of the Robert Lewis Allbritton 1996 Trust is Robert L. Allbritton and the beneficiary of the Barbara B. Allbritton 2008 Marital Trust is Barbara B. Allbritton, wife of Joe L. Allbritton and mother of Robert L. Allbritton. JLA Partners is wholly-owned by Joe. L. Allbritton. Together the owners of WCIV, Inc. are referred to herein as the "Allbritton Family."

In the first step of this internal corporate restructuring, WCIV, Inc. will create a wholly-owned subsidiary, Allholdco, Inc. which will, in turn, create Charleston Television, LLC. The FCC licenses held by WCIV, Inc. will be assigned to Charleston Television, LLC.

The final step will be to merge WCIV, Inc. into Allholdco, Inc., leaving Allholdco, Inc. as the survivor and the 100% parent of Charleston Television, LLC. The current shareholders of WCIV, Inc. will hold the exact same ownership share of Allholdco, Inc. The proposed assignment qualifies for *pro forma* treatment because, after the reorganization, the Allbritton Family will retain control of the licensee, Charleston Television, LLC in the same proportion as it controls the assignor, WCIV, Inc. See 47 C.F. R. §73.3540(f)(2).

The grant of this *pro forma* assignment is in the public interest because it will permit the proposed licensee to continue to provide coverage of late-breaking news and sporting events from various locations in the Charleston, South Carolina metropolitan market to WCIV(TV) and its commonly owned sister stations throughout the United States as well as permit the licensee to provide remote production services in conjunction with its news programming.
