Dear Ms. Dortch:

In response to inquiries from Commission staff, DISH Network Corporation, New DBSD Satellite Services G.P., and Gamma Acquisition L.L.C. (collectively, "DISH") request that the Commission update its databases to reflect the consummation of the transactions approved in the above-referenced proceeding. DISH previously filed a notice of consummation with the Commission regarding these transactions.¹

Specifically, DISH requests that the International Bureau's Filing System be updated to reflect the fact that the licenses formerly held by TerreStar License Inc., Debtor-in-Possession, (Call Signs S2633, E090061, E060430, E070098, ITC-214-20100513-00194, and ITC-214-20100513-00194) have been transferred to DISH's wholly owned subsidiary, Gamma Acquisition L.L.C. DISH also notes that the bankruptcy proceeding involving TerreStar License, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession, has been terminated.
