Description of the Application and Public Interest Statement

Pursuant to Section 25.119 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.119, Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P., Debtor-in-Possession ("HPT DIP") hereby seeks Commission consent to the assignment of its earth station licenses to reorganized Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. ("New HPT").

On June 23, 2011, Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. ("HPT") filed a petition for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code with the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Hawaii. HPT emerged from bankruptcy on June 6, 2012, as reorganized Hawaii Pacific Teleport, L.P. ("New HPT"). The restructuring process enabled HPT to strengthen itself financially and position itself to achieve long-term success in the satellite teleport market.

Grant of this application will serve the public interest by maintaining service to New HPT's current customers. New HPT will continue to provide a crucial link between numerous geographically remote Asian markets and the Americas. In addition, it will secure the future of such links by enabling New HPT to operate with an enhanced financial position and maximize the value of its capabilities and assets. After its financial restructuring, New HPT will be a stronger competitor and better able to offer advanced solutions over its satellite facilities. Accordingly, the proposed transaction will serve the public interest and is therefore consistent with Section 310(d) of the Communications Act.
