PRO FORMA ASSIGNMENT OF LICENSES FROM KOCH PIPELINE COMPANY, LP TO FLINT HILLS RESOURCES, LP

NARRATIVE STATEMENT

By this application, Flint Hills Resources, LC (“Applicant”), a Kansas limited liability company, seeks approval for the *pro forma* assignment of two Ku-band VSAT licenses held by Koch Pipeline Company, LP (“KPL”), a Delaware limited partnership. The assignment is part of a corporate reorganization.

Applicant and KPL are both indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries of Koch Industries, Inc. (“Koch”), one of the largest private companies in the United States. Koch is a multinational company engaged in multiple businesses, with more than 120,000 employees across about 60 countries.
