

WAIVER REQUEST

MGW Networks, L.L.C. (“MGW”) and Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC (“CCCM”) hereby notify the Commission that on September 2, 2022, CCCM assigned receive-only earth station registrations E180478 and E180478A to MGW. This assignment took place in connection with the sale of a rural cable television system serving residents in and around Goshen, Virginia. Due to an inadvertent administrative oversight, however, this assignment was not reported to the Commission within thirty days as required by Section 25.119(j) of the Commission’s rules.¹ The parties therefore respectfully request a waiver of Section 25.119(j) so that this notification may be accepted and processed *nunc pro tunc*.

The Commission may waive its rules for good cause shown, and such is the case here.² Specifically, the requested waiver will allow MGW to continue receiving interference protection for the subject receive-only earth stations in the same manner as these stations have been protected for many years. In this regard, no party would be prejudiced by this request which simply preserves the interference-protection *status quo* for these stations. Absent grant of this request, MGW has no reasonable alternative means to obtain interference protection for these stations, or to report the assignment of the earth station registrations to the Commission.

The parties therefore respectfully submit that good cause exists to waive Section 25.119(j). Doing so will allow this notification to be processed and accepted *nunc pro tunc*, both ensuring the continuing accuracy of the Commission’s records and allowing MGW to avoid any potential interruption of long-standing rural cable television service that could be caused by a loss of the earth stations interference protection. Accordingly, grant of the requested waiver will serve the public interest, convenience and necessity, and thus favorable Commission action in this instance is warranted.
