Subject: Satellite licenses

Dear Ms. Ponti:

PetroCom License Corporation ("PetroCom") asks that the following corrections to its satellite authorizations be made. First, our review of PetroCom's license (call sign: E990070) reveals the following typographical errors. Under Section B, Particulars of Operation, item 2, the reference under associated antenna should be to the remote, not to the hub. In addition, Section B should have an entry containing operating information for the hub receiving frequency bands. We request that the FCC issue a corrected license to PetroCom. Please forward this license to the above address.

Second, earlier this year Petroleum Communications, Inc. completed a pro-forma transfer of control of its satellite earth station licenses to PetroCom. However, one C-band license, Call Sign E980371 and six Ku-band licenses, Call Signs (1) E920639, (2) E920640, (3) E920641, (4) E930376, (5) E930377, and (6) E940063 have not been updated in the FCC's database to reflect the assignment. We hereby request that the FCC update its records to reflect the transfer of these licenses to PetroCom License Corporation. If you require, I can provide copies of the assignment application, the FCC Public Notice granting the assignment and letter notification to the FCC that the assignment was consummated.
