Re: Deletion of Call Sign E010134 from IBFS Database

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Crown Communications Corporation ("Crown"), I am requesting that Call Sign E010134 be deleted from the Commission's IBFS license database ("IBFS").

On October 16, 2001, Crown was granted a license for E010134 (see File No. SES-LIC-20010511-00921). This Earth Station was never constructed, and the authorization was automatically cancelled pursuant to Section 25.133(a) of the Commission's Rules, and the specific condition of the license stating that the "authorization shall be automatically forfeited if the station does not meet each required construction deadline by the required date of completion" (10/16/2002). Even though the license was automatically terminated, the Earth Station was never deleted from IBFS, and Crown continues to receive invoices for annual regulatory fees for this Earth Station.

Our office and Crown have made several prior attempts to correct this error, but the Call Sign E010134 still appears in the IBFS database. See attached letters from me, dated May 27, 2005 and Stacey Werner, dated March 8, 2004. See also, attached email correspondence to the Commission's Revenue Receivable Operations Group, dated November 8, 2004.

In order to prevent this problem from recurring this year, please have Call Sign E010134 deleted from IBFS as soon as practicable.
