Please enter this letter on the docket for the above-captioned application. This letter is to request that the Commission continue to defer action with respect to this application for the reasons stated in our "Unopposed Petition to Defer of Executive Branch Agencies" dated April 5, 2004. The applicant and the Department of Justice, including the FBI, and Department of Homeland Security, are continuing to negotiate on an agreement to address certain concerns, but such negotiations have not yet reached a conclusion.
