Dear Ms. Lam:

Pursuant to the requests contained in your letter to John W. Whetstone dated July 1, 2003, AvL Technologies has decided to reduce the Points of Communications from ALSAT to the U.S. domestic satellites AMC 4, AMC 6, Telstar 6, Telstar 7, and Galaxy XR. Accordingly, we are working with PanAmSat, Loral Skynet, and SES Americom to get the necessary frequency coordinations and affidavits.

All of the listed satellite operators believe that it is their best interest to have AvL license our antennas for the purpose of doing demos for prospective customers, but have requested additional time to address the technical issues before providing the necessary affidavits. Some of this additional time is due also to many key people being on vacation.

AvL Technologies requests that additional time be given before our application is dismissed and the filing fees forfeited because of the somewhat non-standard nature of this license application and the additional time that is required to compile the requested information.
