The filing is for a temporary-fixed earth station. It is not a mobile truck. It is transportable, temporary-fixed, system which consists of the antenna and electronics (that are contained in an Anvil case). In general, the earth station operator will take the antenna and equipment to a fixed location, set it up, and perform a temporary broadcast/transmission.
