NewCom International ("NewCom"), by undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 25.133 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.133, hereby submits this letter to notify the Commission that construction of the above-referenced satellite earth station has been completed. The license for this earth station was granted to NewCom on August 13, 2004.¹

NewCom certifies that the station became operational in June 2004² and will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation. NewCom also certifies that the station has been constructed as authorized and each antenna facility has been tested and is within 2 dB of the pattern specified in Section 25.209 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.209.
