

Pursuant to Section 25.133 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.133, Twin Cities Public Television Inc. ("Twin Cities"), licensee of Satellite Earth Station E930472, hereby notifies the Commission that it has commenced operation of the Earth Station pursuant to the license granted on August 28, 2006, File No. SES-LIC-20060705-01110.

As required by Section 25.133, Twin Cities makes the following certifications: The facility as authorized became operational on February 5, 1994, with respect to the 6.1 meter antenna and on August 8, 1997, with respect to the 4.5 meter antenna.<sup>1</sup> Each antenna has been tested and found to be within 2 dB of the pattern specified in Section 25.209 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.209. The Earth Station will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation.


