On August 14, 2008, L-3 Communications Titan Corporation (L-3 Communications) requested that its application for authority to operate one mobile earth station terminal to provide Land Mobile Satellite Service in the continental United States using the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.7-12.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands be designated "permit-but-disclose" for purposes of the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission's) rules governing *ex parte* communications. Letter to Marlene H. Dortch, Secretary, Federal Communications Commission, from Paul Moller, VP, Intellicom Technologies, Inc., Consultant to L-3 Communications, dated August 14, 2008. We find that designating this matter as "permit-but-disclose" will facilitate the resolution of complex policy issues raised in the application. We, therefore, designate the above captioned proceeding as "permit-but-disclose" effective August 26, 2008. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.1200(a), 1.1206, and 1.1208 note 2. This action is without prejudice to any determination regarding the processing of the application.
