PetroCom License Corporation ("PetroCom"), by its counsel hereby requests, pursuant to Section 25.133 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), extension of time to commence operation of the earth station facilities associated with FCC File No. SES-LIC-20070622-00852, call sign E070119.

These facilities were initially authorized on July 31, 2007. As the FCC is aware, PetroCom has tested these earth station facilities at a shipyard in Ingleside, Texas pursuant to special temporary authority ("STA"). The earth station has been shipped to the Tahiti - Green Canyon 640 Oil Platform in the Gulf of Mexico for permanent installation. PetroCom expects that shipping and installation will be complete and operations will commence by August 31, 2008.

Because operations will not commence until after July 31, 2008, as required by 47 C.F.R. § 25.133(a), PetroCom requests a thirty (30) day extension of the time period to commence operations. The delay in commencing operations was beyond PetroCom's control because deployment was tied to the completion of the construction of the platform by Chevron Corp., which owns and operates the platform. However, the construction of the platform is now complete and PetroCom can complete installation of the earth station facilities. The extension will serve the public interest by ensuring that PetroCom is able to provide much-needed communications services to its customers on oil rigs in the Gulf of Mexico.
