
Dear Ms. Dortch:

At the International Bureau's request, Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC hereby submits this letter to provide supplemental information regarding the purpose of the L-band antennas associated with the above-referenced earth station applications. These antennas will be used to transmit and receive a relatively low power beacon signal that the Ground Based Beamforming system will use for precision beam pointing corrections (i.e. a space operations service), which is permissible under ITU Radio Regulations and the FCC's rules. *See, e.g., 47 C.F.R. § 2.1(c)* (space operation functions, such as space tracking, space telemetry, and space telecommand, "will normally be provided within the service in which the space station is operating"); *see also* SES-LIC-20080212-00153 (granted April 14, 2008) (granting fixed earth station application to use S-band MSS frequencies). The L-band antennas will not provide any end-user communications functionality.
