Re: New C-Band and Ku-Band Earth Stations

Pursuant to §25.115 of the Rules and Regulations (“Regulations”) of the Federal Communications Commission, Harris CapRock Communications, Inc., by way of the underlying application, respectfully requests Commission authority to operate two new fixed earth stations on the same location.

The antennas are a Ku-Band Seatel 9711 (2.4m) and a C-band Seatel 9797 (2.4m). The latter does not strictly comply with Section 25.209 of the Regulations. However, applicant provides off-axis EIRP tables according to 25.218 and 25.115(h) as supporting documentation for request for routine processing treatment.

A frequency coordination study was conducted for the Seatel 9797 and the results of the study indicate that no unacceptable interference will result with existing, proposed or prior coordinated radio facilities.
