Pursuant to Section 25.133 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission"), Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") certifies that it has completed construction and begun operation of its Nuevo, Riverside, California E170039 earth station facility. The Commission granted Intelsat license to operate this earth station facility on June 5, 2017. The station became fully operational on or about September 15, 2010.<sup>1</sup> The earth station antenna authorized by the E170039 license has been tested and operations are consistent with Part 25 of the Commission's rules. The antenna authorized pursuant to the license will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation.
