Pursuant to Section 25.133 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”), Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) certifies that it has completed construction and begun operation of its Hagerstown, Maryland E170081 earth station facility. The Commission granted Intelsat license to operate this earth station facility on July 20, 2017. The station became fully operational on or about March 30, 2017.<sup>1</sup> The earth station antenna authorized by the E170081 license has been tested and operations are consistent with Part 25 of the Commission’s rules. The antenna authorized pursuant to the license will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation.
