Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 25.133(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.133(b), Alaska Communications Internet, LLC ("Alaska Communications Internet") certifies that it has completed construction and begun operation of the earth station facilities authorized under the above-referenced satellite earth station network license. The Commission initially granted this license to Alaska Communications Internet on February 16, 2018.<sup>1</sup> The stations authorized thereunder were fully operational on or about that date, having been previously constructed and brought into operation pursuant to an earlier grant of Special Temporary Authority, *see* Alaska Communications Internet, SES-STA-20170925-01054. The earth station antenna network authorized under Call Sign E170205 has been tested and operations are consistent with Part 25 of the Commission's rules.<sup>2</sup> The antennas authorized pursuant to the license will remain operational during the license period unless the license is submitted for cancellation.

Those facilities were constructed and operational on or about the June 27, 2018 date of that Public Notice, having been previously brought into operation pursuant to grants of Special Temporary Authority, *see* Alaska Communications Internet, SES-STA-20180413-00353 and SES-STA-20180427-00413.
