SES Americom, Inc., pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, hereby updates the record with respect to the above-captioned applications for earth station operating authority to confirm that each of the antennas identified in the applications are necessary to effect the clearing of the 3.7-4.0 GHz band and ensure SES maintains its ability to control its satellites and receive international content as described in the transition plan filed on August 14, 2020.¹ These antennas are located at the two consolidated sites identified by SES in its transition plan.
