**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE OF INTELSAT INFLIGHT LICENSES LLC**

Intelsat Inflight Licenses LLC (“Intelsat”), by counsel, hereby requests leave to file a consolidated response on February 25, 2021 to pleadings submitted by Kuiper Systems LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Amazon (“Amazon”), O3b Limited (“O3b”), and Verizon regarding the above-referenced application.<sup>1</sup>

**I. DISCUSSION**

On February 12, 2021, O3b and Verizon served their pleadings on Intelsat via email. Amazon also filed its pleading on February 12, 2021 and served Intelsat via first-class mail. Thus, pursuant to the rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”), Intelsat’s responses to O3b and Verizon are due on February 22, 2021, while its response to Amazon is due on February 25, 2021.<sup>2</sup> Given the commonality of matters discussed in these

pleadings and the limited resources of the Commission, a consolidated response addressing all the pleadings filed would be appropriate and administratively efficient.

Intelsat has advised the Commission's staff, Amazon, O3b, and Verizon of this request. Counsel for Amazon, O3b and Verizon have indicated to counsel for Intelsat that they have no objection to Intelsat filing a consolidated response on February 25, 2021 and that they will accept service by email. Additionally, Intelsat agrees to extend the deadline for replies by three days and will accept service of any replies by email.<sup>3</sup>

## II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, Intelsat respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Consolidate.
