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Hi Kerry,

I hope you had a nice weekend.

Are you available to have a call to discuss a few matters related to O3b's current license and pending applications? Specifically:

1. O3b's Hawaii mPOWER gateway application (file number SES-LIC-20200721-00777; call sign E202133) was placed on public notice on March 24, 2021. We wanted to see if there are any updates on this pending application.
2. We have plans to begin testing our Phoenix mPOWER gateway antennas (file number SES-LIC-20210217-00350; call sign E210037) beginning on July 26, and our Hawaii gateway antennas beginning around the middle of August. We wanted to let you know that we are planning to file an STA for our Phoenix tests in the next few days.

3. The Commission granted O3b's Haleiwa, Hawaii Modification (File Number: SES-MOD-20190207-00084; call sign E100088) in part but deferred the portion of the application seeking authority to operate in the 29.1-29.3 GHz and 19.4-19.6 GHz mobile satellite service feeder link bands pending either a showing of compatibility with existing operations in that band or completion of coordination with other users of the band. O3b and Iridium have completed coordination of O3b's planned operations in the 29.1-29.3 GHz and 19.4-19.6 GHz bands. O3b asks that the Commission grant the deferred portion of the application and authorize O3b's use of the 29.1-29.3 GHz and 19.4-19.6 GHz bands consistent with the coordination agreement between O3b and Iridium.

Suzanne and I are available tomorrow the 29th before 10am or after 4:00 pm, and Wednesday the 30th before 10:00 am. Do any of those times work for you?
