Dear Ms. Dortch:

RS Access, LLC (“RS Access”) wishes to participate in any Commission proceeding regarding the disposition of the above referenced application filed March 5, 2021. In the request, SpaceX Services, Inc. (“SpaceX”) seeks authority to deploy unlimited earth stations in motion in the 12.2-12.7 GHz (“12 GHz”) band, among other frequencies. The 12 GHz band is employed by RS Access and is subject to an ongoing Commission rulemaking.<sup>1</sup>

In a proceeding not designated for a hearing, any person who files a “written submission referencing and regarding such pending filing” shall be a party to the proceeding.<sup>2</sup> As a result of this notice, the Commission should consider RS Access to be a party in this proceeding for the purpose of the Commission’s *ex parte* rules<sup>3</sup> and should not allow *ex parte* presentations or other communications unless the undersigned, on behalf of RS Access, receives advance notice and an opportunity to be present.<sup>4</sup>
