("SpaceX Services") recently filed supplemental information in further support of its application for a blanket license authorizing operation of next-generation end-user earth stations ("UTs") for use at fixed locations.¹ Unfortunately, footnote 1 of that submission included an incorrect citation to an updated IEEE standard.
