Ka-Band Earth Station – Staunton, VA Frequency Coordination Report 28 GHz

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1. Summary of Results

On behalf of ViaSat. Inc., Comsearch issued coordination notice under Section 25.203(c) and Section 25.136(a)(4) of the FCC's rules for all existing and proposed terrestrial licenses within the coordination contours of their proposed Ka-Band earth station in Staunton-VA, which will transmit at 28 GHz¹. Prior-notification emails were sent to the licensees and a copy of the notification data is provided in section four of this report. The earth station coordination was finalized on December 23, 2020.

No objections were received from any of the incumbent 28 GHz licensees.

2. 28 GHz Common Carrier and LTTS Coordination

In accordance with FCC Rules and Regulations, the Ka-Band earth station in Staunton, VA was prior-coordinated by Comsearch. A notification email, datasheet and Google Earth file showing the area around the site outside which the -77.6 dBm/m2 per MHz threshold value is not exceeded for this earth station were sent to the following 28 GHz common carrier fixed microwave licensees. These licensees are authorized to operate temporary fixed operations from 27.5 – 29.5 GHz on a nationwide basis or local basis.

A notification email, datasheet and Google Earth file showing the area around the site outside which the -77.6 dBm/m2 per MHz threshold value is not exceeded for the Ka-Band earth station in Staunton, VA were also sent to the following 28 GHz local television transmission licensee. This licensee is authorized to operate temporary fixed operations from 27.5 – 29.5 GHz on a nationwide basis.

3. 28 GHz UMFUS Coordination

Two 28 GHz UMFUS licensees were identified within the coordination distance of the proposed earth station. The proposed earth station will operate on frequencies that overlap Channel L1 & L2 of the UMFUS service. The total frequency allocation for Channels L1 & L2 of the UMFUS spectrum appears below.
