
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Lockheed Martin Corp., by its attorney and pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, hereby submits for inclusion in the file of the above-referenced application a copy of an addendum to the frequency coordination report from Comsearch that accompanied the June 15, 2006 application. This addendum was initially provided to the Commission staff electronically on July 6, 2006, by Comsearch employee Tim Crutcher, in response to an inquiry from the staff.

On July 5, 2006, the attorney for Lockheed Martin contacted Comsearch regarding the FCC filing for the Clarksburg, Md earth station. There were questions regarding coordination with the LTTV operators. Namely, there was no list of LTTV operators included in the Coordination Report. Following is a summary of the results of our review and response to the concerns.

Pursuant to Part 25.203(c) of the FCC Rules and Regulations, the satellite earth station proposed in this application was coordinated by Comsearch.

Coordination data for this earth station was sent to the below listed carriers with a letter dated 02/03/2006. This list was inadvertently omitted from the original coordination report. The following carriers or their protection agent received the February 3, 2006 coordination notice and there were no potential interference conflicts reported.
