Pursuant to the Commission's Order granting Inmarsat, Inc.'s request to streamline licensing of L-band Mobile Satellite Service terminals,<sup>1</sup> Honeywell International, Inc. here requests redesignation of the points of communications listed on the license for Call Sign E000156 to "ISAT."
