Dear Ms. Dortch:

Applicant Vizada, Inc. hereby withdraws its pending request for ALSAT authority for the C-Band Earth Station on Vessels (ESV) remotes which are the subject of the above-referenced application.

Vizada had requested ALSAT authority to allow the ESV remotes to access any U.S. satellite and non-U.S. satellites on the U.S. Permitted List to provide C-Band ESV service via its Santa Paula, CA Teleport, Callsign WB36. Vizada now realizes that the Commission's regulations do not grant ALSAT authority to C-band ESV operators. Vizada therefore respectfully withdraws its pending request for ALSAT authority for the C-Band ESV remotes.

In the above-referenced application, Vizada requested specific authority to use NSS-7 as a point of communication to provide the C-band ESV service. At the present time Vizada is only using NSS-7 as a point of communication to provide service pursuant to the Special Temporary Authority granted by the Commission (File No. SES-STA-20081208-01553). In the event that Vizada desires at some future time to utilize any other satellite as a point of communication to provide the service, an application for such authority will be filed with the Commission.
