Dear Mr. Blais,

The purpose of this letter is to withdraw certain Point of Communication Authorizations (POC) requested in captioned Modification Application (MOD) for WB36 Hub Antennas. The reason for this is that some of the satellites for which C-Band and Ku-Band POC was requested are no longer active and the L-Band POCs that were requested for specific Inmarsat satellites are not needed because the L-Band POC is provided by "ISAT List" Authorization. So, as set forth in more detail below, this letter respectfully withdraws the POC requests that are not needed.

This is the only change that is being requested to the MOD. All other aspects of the Schedule B remain the same. Only the requests for the POCs further specified below are being withdrawn.

It is noted that in addition to the update of the POCs for the Hub Antennas which are addressed by this withdrawal the MOD also requested certain updates of other WB36 Site Identifiers/ Antenna Facilities (Site ID) as well as authorization for two new Site IDs. As noted above, no change is being requested to those other parts of the MOD so in order to avoid confusion I will set forth all the Site IDs covered by the MOD and specify as to each whether it is subject to this correction or is unchanged. I will then restate the POCs still being requested for the various Site IDs so as to make it as clear as possible.

Here are all the Site IDs that are covered by the MOD:
