AC BidCo LLC (“AC BidCo”), by its attorney and pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, hereby updates the above-referenced application to modify AC BidCo’s Earth Stations Aboard Aircraft license (the “Modification Application”), which sought to add satellites as authorized points of communication.

Specifically, AC BidCo supplements the orbital debris mitigation information for the APSTAR-6C spacecraft to note that the mass of helium in each of the three sealed tanks will be 1.3 kg at the satellite’s end of life. An updated copy of the table found on page 4 of the orbital debris mitigation statement (page 49 of the attachments to the Modification Application) is below:
