In contrast, the following three of these STA requests are no longer needed and are hereby withdrawn: SES-STA-19990312-00371; SES-STA-19990312-00368; and SES-STA-19990312-00370.

In addition, AMSC clarifies that all of the STA requests referenced in Mr. Repasi's letters are requests for extension of STAs previously granted by the Bureau. These original STA grants currently remain effective in accordance with Section 25.161(b) of the Commission's rules.
