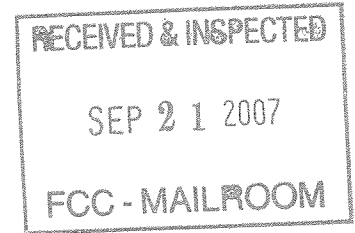

(formerly Telenor Satellite, Inc.) hereby requests that the Inmarsat-3 AOR satellite at 54° W.L. be removed as a point of communication from the licenses for the three earth stations referenced above. The Inmarsat-3 satellite formerly at 54° W.L. has been relocated to 142° W.L., and the three earth stations referenced above (all of which are in Southbury, CT) do not communicate with that satellite at its new location.
