Dear Ms. Dortch:

AvL-Technologies, Inc. (“AvL”) herein responds to the comments (“Letter”) of SWE-DISH Satellite Communications, Inc. (“SWE-DISH”), dated October 15, 2004, with respect to the above-referenced AvL earth station application amendment (“Amendment”).<sup>1</sup>

We note that SWE-DISH specifically does not raise any “objections to the amendment per se”; specifically recognizes that the amendment is “minor” and that “nothing significant” has been changed by the amendment; and specifically raises no new matters “not included” in the AvL Amendment and not previously “addressed” by SWE-DISH (Letter, paragraphs 1 and 2).

<sup>1</sup> We note, from the Letter-head, that SWE-DISH has retained new counsel, which could explain the lack of actual receipt of past service. We also note that the new SWE-DISH counsel was personally aware of the amendment at the time it was filed; and that, as SWE-DISH counsel itself recognizes, the Amendment was placed on Public Notice despite only “minor” “non-substantive” and “procedural” (1.1202) clarifications not requiring such treatment.
