The above-referenced earth station modification applications were filed by DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV") seeking approval to add a DIRECTV satellite at Canada's 72.5° W.L. orbital location as a point of communication and to reflect the operation of uplink services to 72.5° W.L. These earth station modification requests were preceded by an application from DIRECTV for Special Temporary Authority to move its DIRECTV 5 satellite to 72.5° W.L.¹ EchoStar Satellite LLC ("EchoStar") has filed substantive comments, reply comments, and additional comments in connection with that request.² The above-referenced earth station modification applications are part and parcel of DIRECTV's proposal to relocate its DIRECTV 5 satellite, and raise identical issues.³
