Modification to E980235 to add a 3.8m Hub**


Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 21, 2005, Stratos Offshore Services Company ("Stratos") filed the above-referenced modification application to add a 3.8m Hub station to its licensed VSAT network (E980235).

In order to satisfy the Commission's input power density limit of -14 dBW/4 kHz, the staff of the International Bureau has advised Stratos that the power to the proposed 3.8m hub needs to be reduced by 0.6 dBW for the emissions set forth in the application that have a maximum EIRP density of 39.80 dBW. By this letter, Stratos supplements its modification application and agrees to reduce by 0.6 dBW the EIRP density and EIRP for these emissions in order to satisfy the Commission's Rules.
