
Dear Mr. Bender:

On October 5, 2005, Space Imaging LLC (Space Imaging) filed the above-captioned applications to modify its existing license to reduce the receive-only elevation angle in the 8025-8400 MHz band of this earth station from 5 degrees to 0.0 degrees. Pursuant to Section 25.112(a)(1) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §25.112(a)(1), we dismiss these applications as incomplete.

Section 25.115(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §25.115(b), requires that applications for receive-only earth stations shall be filed on FCC Form 312 and include a Schedule B. Your modification applications did not include a Schedule B. Furthermore, your applications did not include a request for a waiver of this filing requirement.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 25.112(a)(1) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §25.112(a)(1), and Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegations of authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, we dismiss these applications without prejudice to refiling.<sup>1</sup>
