NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO 47 C.F.R. § 1.65

Chevron USA Inc. ("Chevron"), by its attorney, respectfully submits this Notification pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.65 regarding to the above-captioned applications. These applications requeste modified authority for stations E900691, E900689, E920268 and E900690, and were prepared and electronically submitted to the Federal Communications Commission via the International Bureau Filing System ("IBFS") on November 11, 2005. They have been assigned the file numbers SES-MOD-20051115-01584, SES-MOD-20051115-01583, SES-MOD-20051115-01585 and SES-MOD-20051115-01586.

This confirms our electronic mail request of January 3, 2006 that these four applications be modified by removal of Chevron's request for waiver of Section 25.134(g)(2) of the FCC's rules, which limits the downlink EIRP density of Ku band carriers to +10 dBW/4kHz. In its

applications, Chevron sought permission to radiate at +13 dBW/4kHz. Typically, granting of such a waiver by the Commission requires the permission of the satellite operator, which has not yet been received by Chevron.

As a result, in order to expedite the Commission's processing of the referenced applications, Chevron requests withdrawal of the waiver requests included with these applications.


