Dear Ms. Smith:

On July 25, 2007, Comcast of Washington IV, Inc. (Comcast) filed the above-captioned application to modify the registration of a C-Band¹ receive-only fixed earth station. The application seeks to modify the site coordinates for the authorization. We request that Comcast provide, by amendment, additional information to allow the Commission to continue to process the application.²

In response to item E18 of Schedule B, Comcast indicates that frequency coordination is not required and did not submit a frequency coordination report. However, relocating a C-Band earth station by more than one second in latitude or longitude may change the likelihood of interference from terrestrial services operating in the C-Band on a co-primary basis. Consequently, we request Comcast to provide a new coordination report based on the proposed new site coordinates for the earth station.

Comcast must submit the requested information within forty-five calendar days from the date of this letter. Failure to submit the requested information will result in dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 25.112(c) of the Commission's rules.
