(“BFI”) hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to Section 25.133(b) of the FCC’s Rules (47 C.F.R. § 25.133(b)), that the additional 4.8 meter Ku-Band antenna authorized in the above-referenced file has commenced operation in accordance with the modified license granted on June 9, 2008 (Call Sign E020024).

This letter confirms that the facility has been completed as authorized and that the antenna has been tested and is within 2 dB of the pattern specified in §25.209 of the FCC’s Rules. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 25.209; Attached Certification of David Darakjy. The Earth station will remain operational during the license period ending April 8, 2012, unless submitted for cancellation.
