The National Radio Quiet Zone (NRQZ) office evaluated the above-mentioned transmitter to determine the possible interference impact on our highly sensitive radio astronomy operations.

The National Radio Astronomy Observatory (NRAO), Green Bank, WV, **does not object** to and **recommends for approval** the modification of call sign **KA399** by the FCC.

To assist in the regulatory requirements of this transmitter, the NRQZ office requests that:

1. The applicant **shall** provide the NRQZ office notice of their official filing with the FCC per section 47CFR1.924 (a) (2).
