

FiberSat Global Services, Inc. hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to Section 25.133(b) of the FCC's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 25.133(b)), that FiberSat commenced on March 29, 2009 the Ku-band operations authorized by the above-referenced modification to its Earth station located in Chatsworth, California (Call Sign E990120). The referenced modification application was granted on April 28, 2009, but actual Ku-band operations began in advance of the permanent modification pursuant to Special Temporary Authority, granted March 23, 2009 (FCC File No. SES-STA-20090318-00347).

This letter certifies that the facility has been completed as authorized and that the antenna has been tested and is within 2 dB of the pattern specified in §25.209 of the FCC's Rules. See 47 C.F.R. § 25.209. The Earth station will remain operational during the license period ending June 6, 2024, unless submitted for cancellation.
