**NOTICE**

Amtech Systems LLC (“Amtech”), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) that it intends to file comments with respect to the above-referenced applications by the July 10, 2009 deadline. As required by the *ATC Report and Order*,<sup>1</sup> on April 29, 2009, SkyTerra Subsidiary LLC (“SkyTerra”) filed three identical applications for modification of its Ancillary Terrestrial Component (“ATC”) authority—one for each of its two U.S.-licensed satellites (AMSC-1 and MSV-1) and one for its blanket license for mobile earth stations accessing its Canadian-licensed satellite (MSAT-1). The Commission accepted for filing SkyTerra’s modification application on a space station public notice dated June 5, 2009<sup>2</sup> and an earth station public notice dated June 10, 2009.<sup>3</sup> Thus,

comments on the identical application are permitted on both July 6, 2009 and July 10, 2009.<sup>4</sup> As discussed with FCC staff, Amtech intends to file on July 10, 2009.
