

On November 3, 2009, Drew Caplan, Christian Gates, and Jeff Carlisle of SkyTerra Subsidiary LLC met with John Leibovitz, Tom Peters, Stagg Newman, Arnab Das, and Rohit Dixit of the Broadband Task Force, Ronald Repasi of the Office of Engineering and Technology, and Bob Nelson of the International Bureau to discuss SkyTerra's Mobile Satellite Services (MSS) and Ancillary Terrestrial Component (ATC) technology.
