Pursuant to Section 25.133(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.133(b), Bonneville Holding Company ("Bonneville") hereby certifies that the new replacement 1.8 meter antenna for Earth Station E030045, has been constructed and was placed into operation on September 17, 2009 pursuant to special temporary authority.¹ Bonneville certifies that the antenna facility has been tested and is within 2 dB of the pattern specified in Section 25.209 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.209.
