This section currently specifies Point of Communications authority for "SOUTHBURY to INMARSAT Ltd.-3 satellite(s) @ 54 W.L. in AOR-W (United Kingdom-licensed) (Non-U.S.-licensed)" However, the official name for the Inmarsat satellite @ 54 W.L is Inmarsat-3 F4 satellite. It is therefore requested that the current specification set forth at Section D) 4) be replaced with the following, "SOUTHBURY to INMARSAT-3 F4 satellite(s) @ 54 W.L. in AOR-W (United Kingdom-licensed) (Non-U.S.-licensed)."
