Pursuant to Section 25.133(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.133(b), Bonneville International Corporation ("Bonneville") hereby certifies that the 5.0 meter antenna added to Earth Station E2529, whose license was modified on March 28, 2011, has been constructed and became operational on April 15, 2011.
