

**Astrium Services Government, Inc. – Callsign E000284**

Modification - Request for Renewal of Waiver

Astrium Services Government, Inc. (“ASGI” f/k/a Vizada, Inc.) respectfully submits this waiver renewal request.

In the above-referenced earth station blanket license, the International Bureau granted a waiver to ASGI of footnotes US308 and US315 to the Table of Allocations and Section 25.136 (d) of the Commission’s Rules for Inmarsat-C land-based half-duplex mobile earth terminals (“Inmarsat-C METs”).

The International Bureau granted the subject waiver, in part, on the condition that any subsequent requests for a waiver must contain, “[A]n analysis of MET operations in the United States showing the number of packets each month that exceed 3 seconds in duration.”<sup>1</sup>

ASGI has performed the requested analysis of Inmarsat-C METs and hereby reports that no packets have exceeded 3 seconds in duration.

As noted in the above-referenced File No., in the period since April 2007, ASGI has received no reports of interference to either the Global Maritime Distress and Safety Service (GMDSS), or any safety service, including aviation safety services.

In light of the above facts, we believe that the Commission has good cause to grant a renewal of ASGI’s waiver request. Granting a renewal of the waiver of Footnotes US308 and US315 to the Table of Allocations and Section 25.136(d) of the Commission's Rules would serve the public interest by ensuring continuity of service for ASGI’s customers currently operating Inmarsat-C METs, which include the U.S. Government.
