Dear Ms. Bryant:

Pursuant to a conversation late last week with Mr. Blais, with respect to license modification application SES-MOD-20150421-00250 (ITC Global Call Sign E920640) the following fields require revision.

- Field E56 of the Schedule B (Azimuth Angle Eastern Limit) should be revised to 130.6 degrees.
- Field E57 of the Schedule B (Elevation Angle Eastern Limit) should be revised to 42.0 degrees.
- Field E58 of the Schedule B (Azimuth Angle Western Limit) should be revised to 237.2 degrees.
- Field E59 of the Schedule B (Elevation Angle Western Limit) should be revised to 36.2 degrees.

Please also be aware that the corrected geographic coordinates provided in the Schedule B are for the Site ID, and should be applied to both the existing antenna (Antenna ID 1) and the proposed antenna (Antenna ID 2). These antennas are located within 1 second long/lat of each other at the site.
