

**SUPPLEMENT TO AND  
PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF LICENSE MODIFICATION APPLICATION**

Global Eagle Telecom Licensing Subsidiary, LLC, Debtor-in-Possession (“Global Eagle”) hereby supplements the pending modification application for its Ku-band Earth station at Holmdel, New Jersey (Call Sign E160163) under IBFS File No. SES-MOD-20170908-00994, as amended by IBFS File No. SES-AMD-20181003-03223. Global Eagle withdraws the portion of the application seeking access to the Intelsat 29e satellite at 50° W.L. in the extended C-band uplink frequencies at 12.75-12.823 GHz, 12.851-12.973 GHz, 13.001-13.098 GHz, 13.126- 13.148 GHz, 13.176-13.223 GHz and 13.75-14.0 GHz. This partial withdrawal is necessitated by the fact that the IS-29e satellite is no longer operational. The withdrawal request applies to the following emissions that had been requested for use in the Earth-to-space direction in each of the above listed frequency ranges:
